1. Fees

Applicants are required to pay an initial non-refundable Application Fee when submitting their application. This can be paid by sterling cheque made payable to the IFE or by credit / debit card per the payment section attached to the application form.

5. Engineering Council annual registration fees (following year of entry)

After the first year of entry, annual Engineering Council Registration Fees are collected by the IFE and paid over to the Engineering Council.

6. Payment of fees and annual subscriptions

6.1 Applications for entry into the IFE Registrants Group must be accompanied by the appropriate application fee.

6.2 Once an application has been processed and approved by the Registrants Group and membership of the Institution of Fire Engineers has also been granted, the applicant will be informed. At this time the following subscriptions will be due for payment:

(i) The IFE annual subscription. *Please note that this does not apply to those applicants who are already in membership of the IFE and who have already paid the annual subscription or who have made direct debit arrangements for the payment thereof.*

(ii) The appropriate annual subscription in respect to membership of the Registrants Group

(iii) The appropriate Engineering Council entry registration fee. *Please note that an applicant to the Registrants Group who is already a registered engineer through another Licensed Professional Engineering Institution (PEI) will not be required to pay Engineering Council registration fees. However, registrants can opt for Engineering Council fees to be collected via the IFE rather than another PEI.*

7. Tax relief – annual subscriptions and registration fees

Annual membership subscriptions payable to the IFE, including those in respect to the Registrants Group, may be deducted from the emoluments of any office or employment to be assessed for tax, if defrayed out of those emoluments.

Applicants to the Registrants Group, on registration with the Engineering Council, will be entitled to tax relief on the annual registration fee only. In making a claim for tax relief in respect of the annual Engineering Council registration fees, please indicate clearly that the payment has been made in respect of annual registration fees to the Engineering Council and not to the IFE.
