The last date for accepting late entries is 27 August 2019.</p>														
<p>Refund of Entry Fees Available up to 27 August 2019.</p>	<p>Candidates who change their minds and wish to withdraw from examinations may ask for a full refund of their entry fee up until 27 August 2019. Please note: this is a final cut-off date and no refunds will be made after this date. Please see Terms and Conditions.</p>														
<p>Withdrawing from Examinations (28 August – 16 September 2019)</p>	<p>Please see the Special Consideration policy which sets out the limited situations in which a deferral arrangement may be possible and the supporting documentation which will be required by the IFE in order to progress the request.</p> <p>Where the request is approved, an administration fee of £15.40 will be charged for each examination paper deferred.</p>														
<p>Withdrawing from Examinations (17 September 2019 – 30 October 2019)</p>	<p>Please see the Special Consideration policy which sets out the limited situations in which a deferral arrangement may be possible and the supporting documentation which will be required by the IFE in order to progress the request.</p> <p>Where the request is approved a fee of £18.70 will be applied for each paper deferred. (Note: where candidates defer four papers, the deferral fee will be £56.10)</p>														
<p>Amendment to Examination Entries</p>	<p>Candidates may amend their examination entry without further charge up to 27 August 2019.</p> <p>After 27 August 2019, the IFE will try to meet requests for changes to papers/venues. However, changes may not be possible at this stage and the IFE reserves the right to make an administration charge eg where additional postage charges are incurred.</p>
