



2019 Membership Fees

The membership year runs from 1st January to 31st December and is renewable each January thereafter. Membership renewal invitations are emailed in November/December each year. New members joining in the last quarter of the year (October to December) pay only the following year's membership fee.

Methods of Payment

Direct Debit

You can pay via Direct Debit for all grades of membership from your second year of registration onwards. You can choose to pay annually or quarterly to spread the cost over the whole year. Setting up a Direct Debit is simple; if you have a UK bank account, please complete the [Direct Debit Instruction](#) and return it to us in the post (*emailed versions or photocopies are not acceptable at this time*). New Instructions must be received by 5th January. If you already pay via Direct Debit, you do not need to complete a new instruction unless there is a change to your bank details.
